

Uropetala carovei White, 1843

1♂ – 31.12.1896, Elmsly-Bay, [South Island, New Zealand], Prof. Schauinsland [leg.]. Identity labels: »*Uropetala carovei* White« in Alfken's handwriting.

1♀ – [December 1896], French Pass, [South Island, New Zealand], Schauinsland [leg.].

Identity label: »*Uropetala carovei* A. White ♀ Nov. Zealand« in Selys' handwriting (Fig. 2).

Citation in ALFKEN (1904): »*Uropetala carovei* White. 1♀. French Pass. 1♂. Elmslie Bay, 31./12.1896. Nach brieflicher Mittheilung von SÉLYS - LONGCHAMPS selten.«

Remarks

Comparison of available specimens with the data given by ALFKEN (1904) shows that a few specimens from Hawaii and New Zealand are missing from the present collection at UMB. These are: a ♂ of »*Agrion heterogamias*« collected at Kalae

(Molokai Island, Hawaii), a ♀ of *Pantala flavescens* collected at Maluhia (Oahu Island, Hawaii) and a ♂ and two ♀ of »*Agrion zealandicum*« collected at Chatham Island (New Zealand). Selys obviously retained all these for his own collection. The third author (MW) found the three »*Agrion zealandicum*« specimens in a very poor condition in the IRSN (Brussels).
